

Danish figure skating club is looking for a new Head Coach.

Frederikshavn Skøjteforening is now seeking an experienced and ambitious head coach to lead the training of a club with ambitions housing both elite skaters and skaters at intermediate level.

The Club:

Frederikshavn Skøjteforening is a club of proud traditions. The club dates back to 1964 and has since been one of the leading clubs in Denmark despite a relatively small member crowd of an average of 50 members per. season. The club embraces both elite and width, and it is extremely important to us that with a new head coach we can continue this focus. FSF has premises in Iscenter Nord in Frederikshavn. The centre has been modernized in 2014 and has two ice arenas, where there is ice eight to nine months a year. FSF has won regional and national championships every season in the past 10 years. Skaters have also participated in the Nordic championships over the past many years and has won two bronze medals within the last three years. Furthermore, skaters have participated both in Junior Grand Prix and Junior Olympics.

At intermediate skating level, the club has been at top level for many years, regionally as well a nationally. In addition, we participate in various beginner's competitions.

The job:

As a coach of the FSF, you should coach the ice and off-ice training, accompanying skaters to competitions and tests and plan camps in coordination with the club. In addition, you should make choreography for new programs for all competing skaters, lead a smaller team of trained assistant coaches and in any case enter into collaboration with the board. You are also responsible for organizing training for young as well as teenage beginners. It is important for the club that there is a good mood among all skaters and that coaches, parents and skaters find well-being with each other in and outside of the arena. The job is a full-time job, 37 hours a week and 12-month-employment. Salary is negotiated at the job interview.

About you:

We expect you to have a certified coach training at manager level and experience from similar employment/s from which you can show good results from both training and competitions on regional level, over national level to international level. You have great technical understanding and manage to push our skaters "beyond the edge" concerning performance and music interpretation. You possess leader skills and are capable of bringing your assistants' qualifications into play. At the same time, you get very well along with children in general and to this, have pedagogical insight in relation to training and learning principles. Preferably you speak one of the Nordic languages or English. You are also willing to learn Danish.
